

Waste must be sorted!

A package contains a product such as food, drink, cleaning supplies, or building materials



Only packaging should be left at recycling stations (ÅVS).

No other waste may be placed in or outside the containers at ÅVS.

Plastic packaging

Plastic packaging can include bottles for soap, medicine, dishwashing liquid, shampoo, ketchup. Also plastic containers. Examples: packaging for meat, fish, fruit, bread.



Paper packaging

Paper packaging can include cartons for yogurt, sour milk, juice, one part of the butter container, crispbread boxes, pasta boxes, pizza boxes, and the toilet paper roll.



Metal packaging

Metal packaging can include tin cans, metal tubes, metal lids, foil on certain packages.



Leave packaging

– ask your landlord where the nearest recycling station is!

Glass packaging

It is important to sort by color – colored or clear glass.

A single colored glass bottle can ruin an entire batch of clear glass if sorted incorrectly.

Examples of glass packaging: beverage bottles, jam jars, cooking oil bottles.



The two bins at the house are sorted like this



Food waste

Put here:

Candy, food scraps, fruit peels, coffee grounds and coffee filters, tea bags. Grease from plates or frying pans can be wiped with a paper towel and placed in the food waste.

Only things you could imagine putting in your mouth – but are no longer edible.



Combustible residual waste:

Put here:

Diapers, sanitary pads, tampons, candle stubs, napkins, plastic gloves, envelopes, used dishcloths, used dish brushes, used toothbrushes (not electric – that's electronic waste), vacuum cleaner bags, cotton balls, cotton swabs, eggshells, dog poop bags, cat litter, snus and cigarette butts – make sure they are fully extinguished!
